

**GEC A-Z Recycling Guide – last updated 17/02/2020****A**

Advertising Material	Kerbside recycling bin. Remove plastic wrapping – Coles and Woolworths <a href="#">REDcycle</a> soft plastics recycling bins. Read catalogues online to decrease paper usage.
Aerosol Cans	Empty with lids off. Put both into kerbside recycling bin. If the aerosol can isn't empty then it is considered hazardous waste and should be disposed of appropriately. Butane aerosol cans or canisters such as those used for camping should NOT be put in the kerbside recycling they are highly flammable if any gas is remaining in them. It's best practice to keep them out of the kerbside bin and dispose of them at your local household chemical drop-off service. The <a href="#">Edinburgh North Resource Recovery Centre</a> accepts household hazardous waste.
Agricultural Chemicals	Metal and plastic containers and drums – fungicides, herbicides, insecticides, products, and animal treatments – see <a href="#">DrumMuster</a> website.
Air Conditioners	Take it to the <a href="#">Scout Recycling Centre in Gawler</a> or the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre in Edinburgh</a> .
Aluminium Cans	See cans.
Aluminium Foil	See foil.
Amplifier	<a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North if in good working order, otherwise <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Animal Fur	Green Organics Bin.
Asbestos	Friable asbestos will need to be removed by a licensed asbestos removalist. Contact <a href="#">D &amp; V Services</a> , Salisbury South. Refer to the <a href="#">EPA</a> website for more information.
Australia Post Packaging	Is recyclable. Soft film plastic – Coles and Woolworths <a href="#">REDcycle</a> bins.

Bag Ties	Bread Bag Plastic Tags - place in milk/juice bottle, once full place in recycle bin. Wire Ties - general waste bin.
Bagged Household Waste	General Waste Bin.

Baking Paper	Greaseproof with crumbs removed – kerbside recycling bin.
Balls - Soccer, Football, Tennis etc.	Donate if in good condition, otherwise put it in the general waste bin.
Band aids	General Waste Bin.
Baskets	Cane – green organics bin (even if it is painted or lacquered). Donate if in good condition. Hard plastic – kerbside recycling bin if only one type of material, not mixed with wire, fabric etc. Mixed materials – general waste bin.
Batteries - Car	<a href="#">Scout Recycling Centre Gawler</a> and <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North. Most car workshops, scrap metal dealers and service stations will accept used car batteries for recycling.
Batteries - Household	Batteries should never be put in the recycling bin or in your waste bin. Rechargeable batteries and lithium ion batteries are hazardous and could produce sparks that may start a fire in the trucks or recycling facility. Using rechargeable batteries saves you money and reduces waste. <a href="#">Aldi</a> - any brand, rechargeable or not. <a href="#">Bunnings</a> – including power tool batteries. <a href="#">Town of Gawler Civic Centre</a> .
Batteries - Power tool	<a href="#">Bunnings</a> .
Bedside Tables	Donate if in good condition. <a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North.
Beer Bottles	See Bottles.
Bicycles and Bike Parts	<a href="#">Salvage and Save</a>
Biros	Lids and plastic insert can be placed in a milk/juice bottle. When full, the sealed bottle can be placed in the kerbside recycling bin.
Binders	Good condition – donate, otherwise separate the parts for recycling: Cardboard – kerbside recycling bin Film plastic - soft plastic collection point Coles and Woolworths <a href="#">REDcycle</a> soft plastics recycling bins Metal rings into kerbside recycling bin.
Biodegradable bags	General Waste Bin.
Biscuit Packets/Sleeves	Even the silver-coloured ones – Coles and Woolworths <a href="#">REDcycle</a> soft plastics recycling bins.

Biscuit Trays	Kerbside Recycling Bin.
Blankets	If clean and in good condition, donate to a charity op shop or animal welfare organisation. Clean, torn blankets may be accepted as rags. If soiled, kerbside general waste bin.
Blender	<a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North if in good working order, otherwise <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or <a href="#">Resource Recycling Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Blister Packs (medical)	Containing unused medications – pharmacy. Empty (whether foil and plastic or just foil) – general waste bin.
Bones	Green organics bin – best to freeze and put into the bin the night before collection to prevent odours.
Books	Good condition - donate to libraries, Lions clubs, charity op shops. Poor condition – kerbside recycling bin (take off soft plastic or material covers from hard-backed books).
Bottles	Glass and plastic - beer bottles, wine bottles, glass jars, 10 cent deposit drink bottles. <a href="#">Scout Recycling Centre</a> Gawler. Also kerbside recycling bin, if clean.
Bottle Tops	Metal (e.g. beer) – place inside metal tin and put inside kerbside recycling bin (even if they have a plastic insert within them). Plastic (e.g. soft drink) – place inside milk/juice bottle and put into kerbside recycling bin. Plastic jar tops with cardboard inserts (e.g. instant coffee jars – remove cardboard and place separately into kerbside recycling bin.
Boxes	Cardboard – flattened. Kerbside recycling, <a href="#">Scout Recycling Centre</a> Gawler, or <a href="#">Eco Waste Solutions</a> .
Branches	< 15 cm diameter – kerbside green organics bin.
Bread Bags	Coles and Woolworths <a href="#">REDcycle</a> soft plastics recycling bins Check with your local baker as some supply other re-usable bags. Consider Onya re-usable bread bags.
Bread Bag Plastic Tags	Place in semi see-through plastic milk/juice bottle, once full place sealed bottle in kerbside recycling bin.
Bread Bag Tie Wires	General Waste Bin.
Bread Maker	<a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North if clean and in good working order, otherwise <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or Resource Recycling Centre Edinburgh.

Bric-a-brac	Donate to charity if in good condition. <a href="#">Resource Recycling Centre</a> Edinburgh North or general waste bin, if broken.
Bricks	<a href="#">Eco waste solutions Willaston.</a>
Bubble Wrap	Coles and Woolworths <a href="#">REDcycle</a> soft plastics recycling bins - see Plastic Soft.
Building Waste	<a href="#">Eco Waste Solutions</a> Willaston will take concrete, bricks, timber and stainless steel.
Butcher's and Deli Paper	If clean, kerbside recycling bin.
Butter and Margarine Tubs and Lids	Scrape clean - kerbside recycling bin.
<b>C</b>	
Cabinets	Donate if in good condition. Metal - <a href="#">Scout Recycling Centre</a> Gawler. Wooden – <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh.
Cake Trays	Cake trays – metal or plastic or foil – donate or kerbside recycling bin.
Cameras	Donate if in good condition. <a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North. Otherwise, <a href="#">Bunnings</a> .
Can Lids	See Lids.
Cans	Aluminium, food cans, steel cans - kerbside recycling bin (washed or scraped clean and dried. Sticky food containers like peanut butter would be better washed.)
Cardboard	Flattened, staples and a bit of sticky tape OK - Kerbside recycling bin. Tissues, box only. Remove plastic and put in soft plastics <a href="#">REDcycle</a> bin at Coles and Woolworths. <a href="#">Scout Recycling Centre</a> Gawler and <a href="#">Eco Waste Solutions</a> Willaston also take cardboard.
Carpet and Carpet Underlay	Donate if in good condition. Poor condition use as weed mat in garden or kerbside general waste bin.
Cars	<a href="#">Scout Recycling Centre</a> Gawler. Bring in any type of vehicle, but it must be free of fuel, all oils, radiator fluid, and the battery has to be removed. Don't forget to take any gas cylinders out first.

Cassette Players	Donate if in good condition. Otherwise, <a href="#">Bunnings</a> and the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> in Edinburgh North accept e-waste.
Cassette Tapes and Cases	Donate if in good condition. Also check at the library. Paper inserts and hard plastic hinged cases separately into kerbside recycling bin. Tape ribbons into general waste bin.
Cat Poo and Litter	General Waste Bin.
CD's, DVD's, and Cases	Donate if in good condition. Check with libraries as may need replacement cases in good condition. Damaged - Paper inserts and hard plastic covers separately into kerbside recycling bin. Discs - general waste bin. Check internet for ideas for repurposing.
CD Player	Donate if in good working condition. Otherwise, <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> in Edinburgh North accept e-waste.
Cellophane	If it tears it's cellulose like paper, if it stretches it's plastic. Plastic cellophane (as around bunches of flowers) can go into Coles and Woolworths <a href="#">REDcycle</a> soft plastics recycling bin. Cellulose cellophane goes into the General Waste Bin.
Ceramics and Crockery	Donate if in good condition, otherwise general waste bin.
Cereal Box Liners (Soft Plastic)	Coles and Woolworths <a href="#">REDcycle</a> soft plastics recycling bin.
Chairs	Donate if in good condition. Otherwise, <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> in Edinburgh North will take them.
Charger	Donate if clean and in good working order. Otherwise, <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Chemicals	<a href="#">See Drummuster Website.</a>
Chicken Wire	Small amount cut up or folded into 30 cm lengths – kerbside recycling bin; large amount - <a href="#">Eco Waste Solutions</a> Willaston and <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
China Cups and Crockery	Donate to charity if not chipped or cracked. Otherwise, place it in the General Waste Bin.
Chip Packets and Snack Wrappers	Coles and Woolworths <a href="#">REDcycle</a> soft plastics recycling bin

Chocolate Bar Wrappers	Coles and Woolworths <a href="#">REDcycle</a> soft plastics recycling bin. General waste bin if covered in melted chocolate.
Cigarettes, Butts, or Ash	Kerbside general waste bin. Alternatively give up smoking.
Cigarette Lighters	(Empty) General Waste Bin.
Cigarette Packets	(Soft plastic sleeve removed) – kerbside recycling bin.
Cleaning Cloths and Rags	Some charities accept them to sell as such; otherwise general waste bin.
Cling Film/Cling Wrap	General Waste Bin.
Clothes Dryer - Electric	Donate to charity or <a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North, if in good working order. Otherwise, <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North if broken. Alternatively, the retail company may be able to remove your old appliance when they deliver the new appliance.
Clothing	Clean and in good condition – donate to charity op shops, animal welfare organisations (to sell in their op shops) or swap with friends and family. If dirty, damaged, worn or torn – general waste bin. Try not to fall for the fashionable requirement to buy new outfits every season. Clothing retailers like H&M have garment collection programs for clothing/textiles, which they reuse or recycle.
Coat Hangers	Material – Donate or general waste bin. Plastic – Donate or kerbside recycling bin. Wire – folded up - kerbside recycling bin.
Coffee Cups - Takeaway	Lids – kerbside recycling bin. Cups – general waste bin unless marked compostable.
Coffee Grounds	Green organics bin, home compost bin, or garden.
Coffee Machines	<a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North, if in good working order. Otherwise, <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> in Edinburgh North.
Coffee Pods	<a href="#">Nespresso</a> have a recycling programme for their own capsules, just take them in to your local Nespresso store or fill an Australia post parcel with pods and post to Nespresso.
Compact Disc and Case	See CD

Computers and Equipment	<a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North, if in good working condition. Otherwise, take it to <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Computer Floppy Discs	Hard covered – dismantle into components – wire, plastic or metal clips, and hard plastic casing – into kerbside recycling bin. Floppy disc component – general waste bin.
Concrete	<a href="#">Eco Waste Solutions Willaston</a> .
Confectionary Wrappers	Outside sleeves – e.g. packet for Minties, Mars Bar sleeve – Coles and Woolworths <a href="#">REDcycle</a> soft plastics recycling bins Internal individual wrapper e.g. for Minties, heavily contaminated chocolate wrapper – general waste bin.
Construction and Demolition Waste	Concrete, Bricks, Steel and Timber go to <a href="#">Eco Waste Solutions</a> Willaston. Scrap steel can also be taken to the <a href="#">Scout Recycling Centre</a> in Willaston.
Cooking Oil	See Oils.
Cooking Oil Container	Empty and drained as best as possible with lid on – kerbside recycling bin.
Cooking Stock Packaging	Empty – kerbside recycling bin.
Coolant	<a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North, in household quantities only.
Corks	Check with local schools or internet for use as crafts. Otherwise general waste bin.
Corrugated Iron and Building Materials	<a href="#">Eco Waste Solutions</a> accept concrete, bricks, timber, and steel. The <a href="#">Scout Recycling Centre</a> accepts light steel, like sheet iron and rain water tanks.

Cosmetics	Aluminium packaging and (empty) aerosols such as sprays and foams, caps separate – kerbside recycling bin. Cosmetics packaging – such as empty lipstick, lip gloss, mascara, eye shadow, foundation – kerbside recycling bin. Flexible plastic from skin care products such as wipes /masks – <a href="#">REDcycle</a> soft plastic recycling at supermarkets. Glass bottles and jars, lids – Kerbside recycling bin. Paper and cardboard packaging – Kerbside recycling bin. Plastic containers, pots and lids from hair care, skin care and cosmetic packaging - kerbside recycling bin. Plastic tubes and caps from hair care, skin care, cosmetic packaging (as empty as possible with lids on) or cleaned and dried into kerbside recycling bin. Pumps, sprays, triggers and other closures from any hair and skin packaging - kerbside recycling bin.
Cotton Reels	Plastic – handcrafts, kerbside recycle bin Wooden – handcrafts, Tomboy stitch knitting, otherwise green bin.
Cotton Wool/Buds/Balls	General Waste Bin.
Couches	Donate if in good working condition. Otherwise, <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Cups	Donate if in good, clean condition. Otherwise, Clean - plastic, paper and cardboard – Kerbside recycling bin.
Curtains	Donate to charity op shops if in good condition. Otherwise, <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Cushions	Donate to charity op shops if in good condition. Otherwise, <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> in Edinburgh. At home, put in the General Waste Bin.
Cutlery	Metal – donate if in good condition, otherwise kerbside recycling bin (even with handles of other materials) Plastic – kerbside recycling bin.

Detergent Bottles	Plastic - empty, lids on or off - kerbside recycling bin.
Deodorant Cans	Bottles, roll-ons – empty, lids off - kerbside recycling bin
Dish Washer	<a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North if in good working condition. Otherwise, <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North if broken. Alternatively, the retail company may be able to take your old appliance when they deliver your new appliance.



Disposable Nappies	General Waste Bin.
Disposable Razor	Handle only – kerbside recycling bin. Head with blade – general waste bin. Consider using non-disposable razors.
Dog Poo - Faeces/Waste	General Waste Bin.
Dressers	Donate if in good condition. Otherwise, <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
10 Cent Drink Containers	Rinsed - <a href="#">Scout Recycling Centre</a> Gawler or kerbside recycling bin.
Drinking Glasses	See Glass. Drinking glasses, ceramics, plate glass (window panes) and oven-proof glass and pyrex cannot be recycled via your kerbside recycling services as they are made from a different kind of material, which can't always be melted down and reused. Donate if in good condition or wrap in newspaper if broken and put into general waste bin.
Drinking Straws	Collected in plastic bottle – kerbside recycling bin.
DVD's	In good condition – donate to op shops, Edinburgh <a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Damaged - Paper inserts and hard cases separately into kerbside recycling bin. Put discs in kerbside general waste bin.
DVD Rigid Cases	Ask library if in good condition, otherwise paper and cases separately into kerbside recycling bin.
DVD Players	Donate if in good working condition at op shops or <a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North. Otherwise, <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North will take e-waste.

Earthenware Pots	In good condition - donate to charity. General waste bin if broken.
Egg Cartons	Kerbside recycling bin. Otherwise, <a href="#">Scout Recycling Centre</a> Gawler or <a href="#">Eco Waste Solutions</a> Willaston.
Electrical Household Appliances	<a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North if in good working condition. Otherwise, <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North or <a href="#">Bunnings</a> .
Electric Blankets	<a href="#">Bunnings</a>
Electrical Cords	<a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North.

Electric Hand Tools	<a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North, if in working order. Otherwise, <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Enamel Oven Trays	Kerbside recycling bin (The metal component is recoverable).
Envelopes	Paper envelopes (windows of business envelopes do not have to be removed). A few staples are alright too! Put in the Kerbside recycling bin.
E-waste	Anything that requires an electrical plug or battery to operate – <a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North if in good working order; otherwise <a href="#">Bunnings</a> , <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Eyeglasses	Opticians – can recycle glasses to third world countries. Also Lions Clubs send glasses overseas. Remove glasses from their case and place in a padded bag then send to the following address. Reply Paid 3021 <a href="#">Lions Recycle for Sight</a> PO Box 3021 CLONTARF MDC 4019.

Fabric	Clean and in good condition – donate to op shops. Soiled or torn – general waste bin.
Fans - Electrical	<a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North if in good working condition. Otherwise, <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North or <a href="#">Bunnings</a> .
Fencing Wire	Small amount kerbside recycling bin if cut into 30 cm lengths. Rolls or large amounts to <a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North.
Fertiliser and Soil Bags	Empty Clean plastic and polypropylene potting mix and compost bags – Coles and Woolworths <a href="#">REDcycle</a> soft plastics recycling bins. Shake free of crumbs as much as possible. Fertiliser bags – general waste bin.
Fish and Chips Paper	Food removed – kerbside recycling bin.
Fishing Line	General Waste Bin.
Flares (Out of Date Flares)	Contact Police Station to find nearest collection point.
Flowers	Green Organics Bin.
Foam	Blocks, packaging peanuts, polystyrene, Styrofoam, food trays and containers – kerbside general waste bin. Also see Styrofoam.

Foil	Aluminium foil trays – clean - kerbside recycling bin. Aluminium sheet foil – (including from off yoghurt containers (scraped clean), instant coffee jars and chocolates, from inside of cigarette boxes. Can be in pieces or rolled into a fist-sized ball) – kerbside recycling bin. Foil-lined juice and milk cartons - empty – kerbside recycling bin.
Food	Fruit and vegetable scraps into green organics bin. Raw or cooked bones and meat (try to decrease wastage with meal planning) – green organics bin.
Food Cans	Scraped clean – kerbside recycling bin.
Food Containers	Formed plastic – kerbside recycling bin.
Food Mixers/Processors - Electrical	<a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North if in good working condition. Otherwise, <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North or <a href="#">Bunnings</a> .
Food Packaging	See Plastic - Soft.
Fridges and Freezers	<a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North, if in working order. Otherwise, <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North. Alternatively, have the retail company remove the old appliance when they deliver the new appliance.
Frypans	Donate if in good condition. Metal frypans (including ceramic-coated or non-stick; with or without handles of other materials) – kerbside recycling bin.
Fuel Bottle and Jerry Can - Plastic	Empty and lid off – kerbside recycling bin.
Fuel Can	Empty and lid off (so fuel dregs have evaporated) – kerbside recycling bin.
Furniture	Donate to charity op shops if in good condition or the <a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North. Some charities may organise pick up. If broken, <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North. Wood from untreated indoor furniture can go into green organics bin, even if painted or varnished. Metal parts – into kerbside recycling bin. Laminated wood with glues – general waste bin.

Garden Hose	Donate to charity if in good condition, otherwise general waste bin.

Garden Tools and Equipment	Donate to charity if in good condition, <a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North. Otherwise general waste bin or <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Garden Waste	Green Organics Bin.
Gas Bottles and Cannisters	Pressurised gas cylinders cannot be disposed of in garbage trucks or at landfills, as they present a danger when compacted. Therefore they must be collected separately. Cylinders can be refilled many times in their life. Options for refilling or safe disposal include: <a href="#">Kwik Gas Cylinder Exchange Service and Swap 'n' Go</a> . BOC / CIG, Matheson, Linde, GasTech, Air Liquide, LAA or Liquid Air cylinders should be returned to the manufacturer so that no further rental will be charged to the customer. Household type gas cylinders (eg: LPG, fire extinguishers, CFC, small size industrial cylinders) may be accepted in household chemical collections in your area.
General Waste	To landfill or <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Gift Wrap	Cellophane – Coles and Woolworths <a href="#">REDcycle</a> soft plastics recycling bin. Foil paper – general waste bin. Paper - kerbside recycling bin.
Glad Wrap	See Plastic bags, Cling Wrap, or Plastic Film.
Glass Bottles and Jars	Kerbside recycling bin or <a href="#">Scout Recycling Centre</a> Gawler.
Glass Plates and Drinking Glasses	Donate to charity if not chipped. If broken, wrap in newspaper and place into general waste bin. This type of glass is not recyclable.
Glass - Heat Resistant and Pyrex Dishes	Donate if in good condition, otherwise general waste bin. This type of glass is not recyclable.
Glass	Windows and windscreens – small amount from one window if broken - wrap in newspaper and place into general rubbish bin. More than one window - building waste.
Gloves	Dish washing – kerbside general waste bin. Latex single use – kerbside general waste bin. Plastic food handling – kerbside general waste bin. Gardening – donate if in good condition, otherwise general kerbside waste bin.

	Material – donate if in good condition, otherwise general waste bin.
Green Organic Waste	e.g. lawn clippings; prunings up to 15 cm diameter; flowers; green compostable bags; small amounts of shredded paper, serviettes and tissues – kerbside green bin or <a href="#">Eco Waste Solutions</a> Willaston.
Greeting Cards	Use in crafts, otherwise put in the kerbside recycling bin.

Hair	Green Organics Bin.
Hair Dryer	Donate if in good working condition - <a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North. Otherwise, <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Hand Bags, School Bags, or Sports Bags	Donate if in good condition or swap with friends or family members. Otherwise general waste bin.
Hats	Donate if in good condition or swap with friends or family members. Otherwise general waste bin.
Hazardous Household Waste	<a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North for suitable items.
Heaters	Electrical - <a href="#">Salvage and Save</a> Edinburgh North if in good working order, otherwise <a href="#">Bunnings</a> . Oil – Edinburgh Salvage and Save if in good working order, otherwise <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Hose	See Garden Hose.

Televisions	Donate if in good working condition. Otherwise, take it to <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North. Under the National Television and Computer Recycling Scheme, every company that makes and/or imports televisions and computers into Australia is required to pay for the end of life recycling of these products. There are four organisations that recycle televisions, computers and accessories under the scheme: <a href="#">TechCollect</a> , <a href="#">Drop Zone</a> , <a href="#">E-Cycle Solutions</a> and <a href="#">Electronic Product Stewardship Australasia</a> .
Tetra pak	Empty – kerbside recycling bin.
Timber	Small branches and prunings – green organics bin. Large branches and trunks - <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North. Painted or varnished Treated timber (e.g. creosote or permamine) - <a href="#">Eco Waste Solutions</a> . A tiny piece could go into the general waste bin, but less than a 30 cm length.
Tin Cans	See Cans.
Tissue Box	Plastic window removed - kerbside recycling bin. Plastic window can go in the Coles or Woolworths <a href="#">REDcycle</a> soft plastics recycling bins.

Tissues	Green organics bin, if only a few. Otherwise, put in the general waste bin.
Toasters	Donate if in good working condition. Otherwise, take it to <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Toilet paper roll - cardboard tubes	Kerbside recycling bin.
Tools	Donate if in good condition, otherwise general waste bin.
Toothpaste tubes and toothbrushes	Consider using a bamboo toothbrush as most of the toothbrush can be composted or placed in the green organics bin. Many local facilities can't recycle toothpaste tubes and toothbrushes, because they're made of multiple materials fused together. (Tubes are usually pressed together from several layers; brushes have bristles and grips.)
Towels	Donate to charity op shops if clean and in good condition. If clean, but worn donate to animal rescue organisations. Towels that are torn can catch delicate paws and trip the animals. Towels that are dirty – kerbside general waste bin.
Toys	Donate if in good condition. Consider borrowing from a toy library, instead of purchasing. Batteries from toys – see Batteries. If mainly plastic (batteries removed) can go into kerbside recycling bin. <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North. Otherwise, put them in the general waste bin.
Tree prunings	Less than 15 cm diameter green organics bin. Otherwise, <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North in large amounts.
Twine	General Waste Bin.
Tupperware	Kerbside recycling bin.
TV Unit	Donate if in good condition, otherwise take it to the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Tyres	When tyres are replaced on your car, the tyre company will take the old tyres and recycle them through <a href="#">Tyrecycle</a> . Unwanted tyres from cars, trucks and tractors, with and without rims - <a href="#">Eco Waste Solutions</a> .

Vacuum cleaner	Donate if in good working condition. Otherwise, take it to <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Vacuum cleaner dust	Green organics bin.
Vegetable punnet	Cardboard or plastic - kerbside recycling bin.
Ventolin inhalers	Pharmacy.
Video player	Donate if in good working condition. Otherwise, take it to <a href="#">Bunnings</a> or the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Video tapes	Donate if in good working condition. Otherwise, put it in the kerbside general waste bin.
Video tape cases	Paper inserts – kerbside recycling bin  Plastic cases – if in good condition check with libraries, otherwise kerbside recycling bin.
Vitamin bottles	Empty, lid on or off –kerbside recycling bin.

Wardrobe	Donate if in good condition, some charities will pick up larger items. Otherwise, the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North.
Washing machine	Have the retailer take away the old washing machine when you purchase a new one. Otherwise, take it to the <a href="#">Resource Recovery Centre</a> Edinburgh North in Edinburgh.
Washing powder - boxes and bottles	(empty) - place in the kerbside recycling bin.

Wood	Branches < 15cm diameter – green organics bin. Chipboard, plywood, treated wood – general waste bin.
Wool	Donate if in good condition, otherwise general waste bin.
Wrapping paper	Kerbside recycling bin.
